<p><b>Sound Sticks (ABS)</b></p> 	<p>The English Sound Sticks are small tools that can be used in a large classroom setting to help students discreetly indicate if they know the answer to a question being asked by the teacher.</p> <p>By holding up the sound stick, the teacher can see who knows the answer without publicly exposing those who may not. The method encourages critical thinking by allowing all learners to participate and engage in the learning process, without fear of being singled out.</p> <p>The sound sticks are small enough to be held in a learner's hand and provide a non-verbal cue for the teacher to assess learner comprehension.</p>	<p>R160</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
